#### ***Chaplain's Report - (Father John Auer)***

Thank you for all the love, care, and charity!

Fr. John encourages us to attend the “Sermon on the Mount” presentation by actor Frank Runyon this month (rescheduled for early April).

Father reminded us of some Lenten activities (Daily Mass, Lenten Black Book, Fish Fry's, Stations of the Cross, Holy Week) and three important things to remember during Lent:

1. Prayer
2. Fasting
3. Alms Giving

Remember the 3 great days of Holy Week:

- Holy Thursday (The Lord's Supper)
- Good Friday (recalls the Passion)
- Holy Saturday (where we will welcome 41 new members to our church. 7-8 will be baptized.

Bishop Sheridan is appointing an additional Priest to our parish in 2014. We are need of a Rectory and the church also has plans for a Parish office adjacent to the church. We will have a fundraising effort to support this.

New Pre-school established with Pax Christie starts this fall. Located at Pax.

March 21<sup>st</sup> – Penance Service at 7pm. Will have 10 priests available.

Father also talked about how the Sacraments of Initiation are a “spring board” for all the other sacraments.

Finally, Fr. John’s personal friend for about 40 years and fellow priest, Fr. Don Brownstein, is still fighting epilepsy issues at University Hospital and is in Intensive Care. Fr. Brownstein has been a priest at Ave Maria in Parker and most recently at St. Peter in Monument. Father wants to stress the importance of having a PoA (Power of Attorney), a will, think about whether you want a DNR (Do Not Resuscitate) order, a trust. He is happy to help/council anybody who has questions.
